Sweet Heart Valentine Pattern

Material Needed:

8 Steel Crochet Hook
1 small ball of white # 10 crochet cotton
1 small ball of red # crochet cotton
8 ½ x 11 inch photo paper
Aleene's Quick Dry Tacky Glue

First Layer of Heart

using red thread Ch 110, join to form a ring, being careful not to twist ch.

Rnd 1 (right side):

Ch 1, sc in same ch as joining and in next 109 chs; join in first sc. 110 sc made.

Rnd 2:

Ch 6 (for first dc, ch 3 lp); dc in front strand as same sc as joining; (ch 3, skip next sc, sc in next sc, ch 3, skip next sc; dc in next sc) 12 times; ch 3, skip next sc; sc in next sc, ch 3, skip next sc; dc in next sc keeping last lp on hook, skip next 5 sc, dc in next sc leaving last lp on hook yo draw through all lps; (ch 3, skip next sc, sc in next sc, ch 3, skip next sc; dc in next sc) 12 times; ch 3, skip next sc; sc in next sc; ch 3, join in 3rd ch of first ch 6

Rnd 3:

Ch 3 for beg dc; dc in same dc as joining; (ch 1, dc in same dc) 4 times; ch 3, * [dc in next dc (ch, 1, dc in same dc) 4 times]; rep from * 13 times ; sc in next dc decrease; rep from [to] 12 times; join in 3rd ch of first ch-3. **Tie off.**

Second Layer of Heart

Rnd 1:

Tie onto white to back strand of first sc of

rnd 1 draw up a loop ch 1, sc; (ch 3, sc in back strand of next skipped sc of rnd 2) 25 times, skip the next 2 sc; sc in back strand of next sc of rnd 1; ch 3, skip next 2 sc, sc in next back strand of next sc; ch 3, skip next 2 sc; (sc in back strand of next skipped sc, ch 3) 25 times; join in first sc-52 ch-3 lps made

Rnd 2:

Slip st into first ch-3 lp, ch 3, dc in same ch-3 sp, ch 2, 2 dc in same ch-3 sp (for first shell; (in next ch-3 lp work 2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc for shell in next ch-3 lp) 24 times: sc in next ch-3 lp; (shell in next ch-3 lp) 25 times; ch 3 join in 3rd ch of first ch-3. 50 shells made.

Rnd 3:

Slip st in next 2 dc, slip st in next ch-2 sp ch 1, sc in same ch-2 lp; * [dc in next ch-2 sp, (ch 1, dc in same ch-2 sp) 5 times]; sc in next ch-2 sp rep from * 12 times; rep from [to] once; sc in next ch-2 sp leaving last st on hook sc in next ch-2 sp, YO draw through all lps on hook; dc in next ch-2 sp, (ch 1, dc in same ch-2 sp) 5 times]; sc in next ch-2 sp rep from * 12 times; dc in next ch-2 sp, (ch 1, dc in same ch-2 sp) 2 times; ch 3, dc in next ch-2 sp, (ch 1, dc in same ch-2 sp) 2 times; join in first sc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in first sc; * (dc, ch 2 in next dc) 5 times; dc in next dc; sc in next sc; rep from * 24 times;(dc in next dc, ch 2) 3 times; dc in next ch-3 lp, ch 3, dc in same ch-3 lp ; (ch 2, dc in next dc) 3 times; join in first sc. **Tie off**

Rnd 5: Tie on red to last ch-3 lp made; draw up a lp ch 1, sc in same ch-3 lp, ch 3, sc in same ch-3 lp; ch 3 (sc in next ch-2 sp, ch 3) 3 times; * sc in next sc; ch 3 (sc in next ch-2

sp, ch 3) 5 times; rep from 23 times; sc in next sc ch 3 (sc in next ch-2 sp, ch 3) 3 times; join in first sc; **Tie off.**

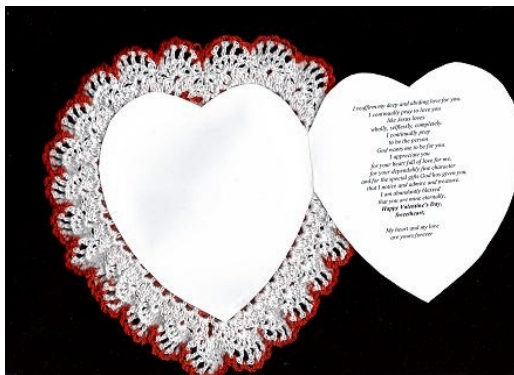
Starch and Block Heart

Make heart pattern

place crochet heart over typing paper
Trace out center of heart onto typing paper with a pencil, then add 1/4 inch all around the heart. Cut out heart pattern.

Make card

Type out card on 8 ½ x 11 inch photo paper.
Fold photo paper in half to make card, then use the heart pattern to position over photo paper image of boy & girl. Trace around heart pattern onto card. On left side of the heart on the fold do not cut out approx 2 inches so the card will open. Glue heart card to back of crochet lace heart. As shown in image. (I use Aleene's Quick Dry Tacky Glue to glue heart),
Write message inside of heart.



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
